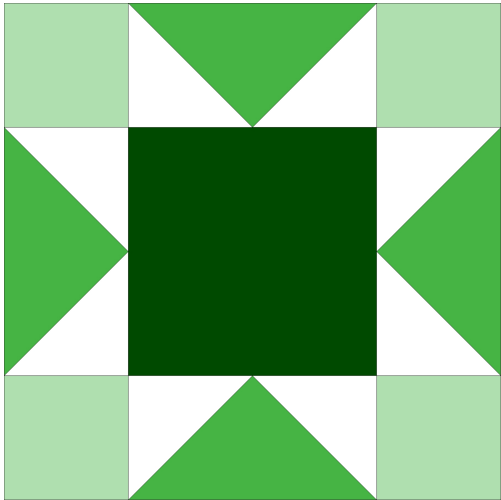


SAWTOOTH STAR – Block #3a  
March 2020



This is a super easy block!

Added interest will come from using 4 fabrics, one dark, one light, and two mediums.

CUTTING:

From Light (background) fabric:

- Cut 4 – 3.7/8” squares for Flying Geese units

From Dark fabric:

- Cut 1 – 6.5” squares for center block

From Medium Fabric A:

- Cut 4 – 3.5” squares for corners

From Medium Fabric B:

- Cut 1 – 7.25” square for Flying Geese units

If you prefer, you can use the same Medium fabric for both the corner squares and the Flying Geese units, but the block will look different.

TO MAKE STAR POINTS:

Flying geese units should measure unfinished 6.5” x 3.5”

- Use Medium B 7.25” square and 4 - Light 3.7/8” squares for 4 at-a-time method (video linked on my website) to make 4 Flying Geese units.
- To center the FG units, fold the Dark block in half both directions and make a small crease in the center on each side. Line up the center of each FG unit with the crease mark and sew together. You may pin or clip the middle and then line up the edges for more accuracy.

ASSEMBLE the block according to the diagram for placement. Flying geese center points should match the center seams of the center blocks.

Completed block should measure 12.5”.
