
SISTER's CHOICE STAR – Block #6 June 2020



Basic method to make 2 HSTs at once:

- Layer 2 squares right sides together.
- Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on one side
- Sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of the drawn line
- Cut along the drawn line

Press the blocks open, typically to the dark side. However, I tend to press these seams open, as they result in less bulk when assembling the blocks. As always, pressing is your choice, and I'm just offering options!

FABRIC CUTTING:

From Light (background) fabric:

- Cut 4 3.5" squares for corner blocks HSTs
- Cut 4 3" squares for corner blocks

From Dark fabric:

- Cut 4 3.5" squares for corner blocks HST's
- Cut 4 3" squares for corner block centers

From Medium Fabric A:

- Cut 1 strip 3" x 11" for top half sashing pieces
- Cut 1 2.5" square for center of the block

From Medium Fabric B: (or use Light fabric)

- Cut 1 strip 3" x 11" for bottom half sashing pieces

TO MAKE STAR CORNERS:

- From 4 Light 3.5" squares and 4 Dark 3.5" squares make 8 HSTs; and square up to 3" (they will finish at 2.5" in the block); Use Basic HST method is listed above, or feel free to choose your preferred method.
- Arrange Light & Dark blocks according to the diagram and sew together as 4-patches

SASHING STRIPS:

- Sew together Medium A & B strips
- Subcut into 4 2.5" x 3" rectangles for sashing

ASSEMBLE the block according to the diagram for placement. Completed block should measure 12.5".
